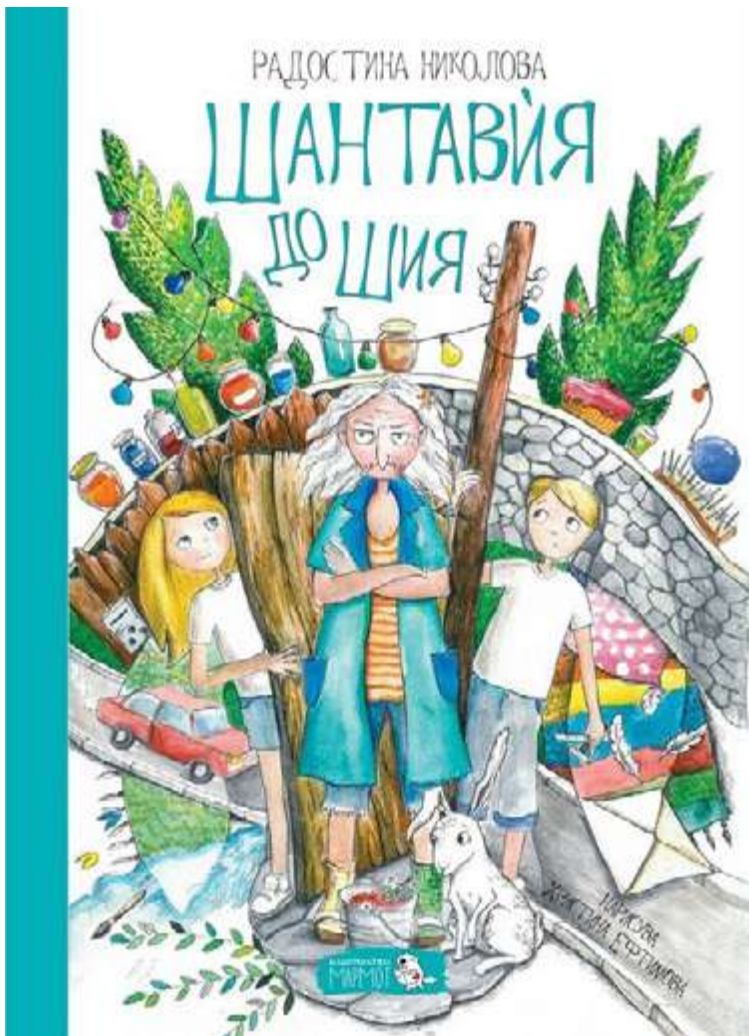

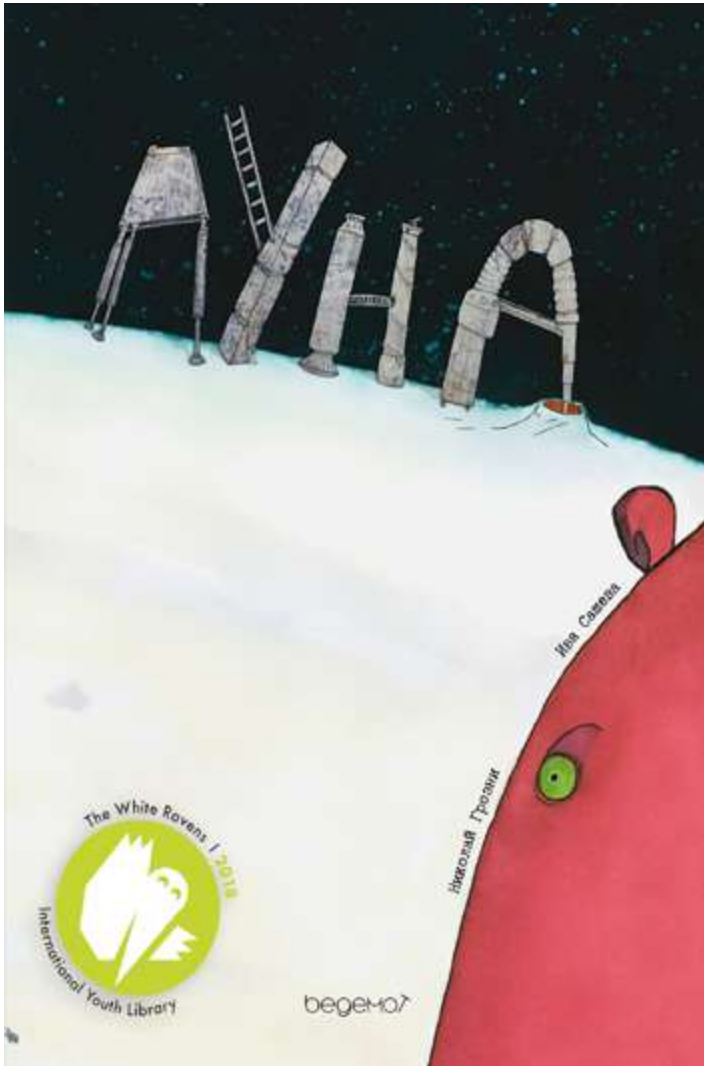

„This graphic novel is based on a true story of three Bulgarian students in 1968. It recreates the events in the capital city of Sofia during the political liberalisation process in the times of the “Prague Spring” and the students’ courageous decisions to express their disagreement with the involvement of Bulgaria and five other communist countries in the invasion of Czechoslovakia.

Veselin Pramatarov succeeds not only in showing the terrors of life in a communist regime, but also in persuading the reader how important it is to stand up for freedom.“

And Nevena Angelova's magnificent illustrations open before children's fascinated eyes the most direct path to this eternal word - universe.

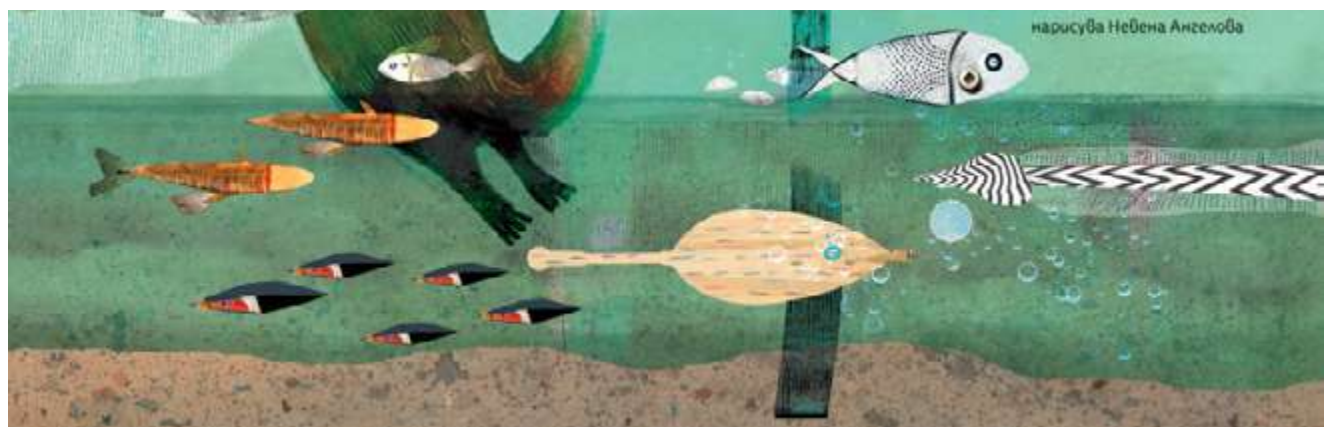
